To all entities using the Navarro County Jail to hold Class C inmates:

Navarro County Jail is fast approaching the population limits set by the Texas Jail Standards Commission. We appreciate your entities' ongoing voluntary help with curtailing the jail population and we are asking that you continue that help. However, even though we are overcrowded, for the protection of the community we will always follow the rule of the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure.

Per the Code of Criminal Procedure, once a magistrate commits a defendant to the county jail for a State Class C Misdemeanor, the Sheriff must accept the prisoner, Tex. Code Crim. Proc. art. 2.18; Tex. Op. Attorney General DM-313 (1995). The Sheriff has no discretion in this matter, but the Sheriff is not required to take a city/municipal prisoner until after that prisoner is taken before a magistrate and committed to the county jail by said magistrate. Id. Tex. Op. Attorney General. JM-151 (1984).

Even though we have no formal agreement to house Class C Misdemeanors without a prior magistrate's commitment, the jail will continue to accept the offenses of Class C Assault Family Violence and Public Intoxication. The jail will accept these two specific offenses with, or without, a prior magistrate's commitment order. Keeping in mind the safety of our citizens, the County feels this is an important exception given the potential dangerousness of Class C Assault Family Violence, and Public Intoxication offenses.

However, the jail is to the point, where booking-in any other Class C defendants may push our jail beyond jail standard requirements and become cost prohibitive. The jail may have to take other high-level inmates it is holding to an out-of-county facility, and pay a commitment rate daily, in order to have room to hold class C inmates who are charged with lesser violations. This has the potential to affect every tax-paying citizen of this county. The County for its part is looking for ways to prevent any negative taxpayer impact.
