

## IN THE COUNTY COURT AT LAW OF NAVARRO COUNTY, TEXAS

## STANDING ORDER REGARDING SB6 Release On Bail Of Defendant Charged With Felony Offense Committed While On Bail

The County Court at Law of Navarro County, Texas, finds and orders as follows:

The Court finds that the Legislature has made significant changes to the statutes regarding bail for Defendants in Texas. The Court further finds it necessary to prepare and sign this order to comply with said statutes and continue the bail bonding procedures for the County Court at Law of Navarro County, Texas

Pursuant to Article 17.027 of the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure, if a defendant is charged with committing an offense punishable as a felony while released on bail in a pending case for another offense punishable as a felony and the subsequent offense was committed in the same county as the previous offense, the defendant may be released on bail only by:

- (A) the court before whom the case for the previous offense is pending; or
- (B) another court designated in writing by the court described by Paragraph (A).

It is hereby ORDERED that pursuant to subsection (B) above, any magistrate in the County of Navarro may magistrate and set bail for defendants described in the above cited Article. This order is the Courts designation in writing as stated in (B) above.
